

RESOLUTION NO. 475

A RESOLUTION FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE MARION COUNTY TAX COORDINATION PLAN TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SB 1185.

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon encourages non-school units of local government to cooperatively review and resolve local service delivery and financing issues in response to the limitations of Section 11.b., Article XI, Oregon Constitution; and

WHEREAS, to be consistent with this policy, the issue of competition between taxing units shall be addressed in each county as provided in Sections 2. through 8. of Senate Bill 1185;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. To comply with the financial needs inventory by increasing the tax base by the six percent (6%) limitation and to levy taxes in the amount of \$725,547 for the 1992-1993 fiscal year.
2. That the tax levy decrease of \$39,303 from the current tax levy of \$764,840 is due to the expiration of the library building serial levy and the swimming pool bond payments.
3. To appoint Elaine Fisk, Finance Director for the City of Stayton, as the City's authorized representative; and David W. Kinney, City Administrator, as the authorized alternate representative for the tax coordination plan meetings.
