

RESOLUTION NO. 236

A resolution calling for the improvement of West Ida and West Washington Streets.

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton may receive a federal grant covering the majority of the cost of improving a portion of West Ida and West Washington Streets in the City of Stayton, if the balance of the costs can be paid for by assessment of the abutting property owners, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Stayton:

1. West Ida Street from Evergreen Avenue to its intersection with West Washington Street, and West Washington Street from Gardner Avenue to its intersection with West Ida Street shall be improved by the construction of curbs and sidewalks and by the grading, graveling and paving of such streets from curb to curb with asphaltic concrete.
2. The boundaries of the improvement district shall consist of the portions of West Ida and West Washington Streets as set out above, together with the lots, blocks or parcels of land abutting said streets. Notice of the improvement shall be given to the owners of the abutting property by publication as provided in ORS 223.367.
3. The costs of any curb and sidewalk construction or reconstruction shall be assessed against the abutting property where such improvement is necessary, and the cost of grading, graveling and paving the street shall be paid, as far as possible,

with the anticipated federal funds to be received therefor,
and the balance of the costs shall be assessed to the abutting
properties equally on a front foot basis.

4. The Council will hear and consider objections or
remonstrances to the proposed improvement by any party aggrieved
thereby at a meeting to be held on 15 day of Aug.,
1977, at 8:30 P.M., at the City Hall, 362 North Third Avenue,
Stayton, Oregon.
