

RESOLUTION NO. 270

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A CITY OF STAYTON PLUMBING PERMIT AND MECHANICAL PERMIT SURCHARGE.

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton is responsible for the administration, collection of permit fees, and record keeping of all Mechanical Permit and Plumbing Permit activities, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton collects fees established by Contractual Agreements with Marion County and pays those fees directly to Marion County, and;

WHEREAS, the City is experiencing an addition in administration and record keeping costs not covered by Plumbing and Mechanical Permit fees, and;

WHEREAS, these additional responsibilities should not be considered an operation service to the general public but a special service, and said special service areas should not be totally funded by the General Fund of the City Budget, now;

THEREFORE, be it resolved:

By the Common Council that a special service charge shall be imposed on all Plumbing and Mechanical Permits in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the Plumbing and Mechanical Permit fees.

The Surcharge shall be due and payable at the time the Plumbing and Mechanical Permits are applied for and all Surcharge Fees shall be received as Revenue in the General Fund of the City of Stayton.

BE IT RESOLVED that this Surcharge shall become in full effect and in force on the First Day of August, 1980.
