

RESOLUTION No. 286

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A MASTER UTILITIES PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton requires a definite yet flexible guide for future growth and construction as related to the sanitary and storm sewer, and water supply and distribution systems; and,

WHEREAS, the City contracted for and generated a report on the City of Stayton's "Master Utilities Plan," prepared by James M. Montgomery Consulting Engineers, which report evaluates the City's water, sanitary sewerage, and storm sewerage systems under present and future loading conditions, recommends improvements over a twenty-year period, and involves the use of flexible hydraulic computer models for design purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the report was developed in conjunction with public workshop sessions which resulted in Council input; and,

IT APPEARING that the Master Plan, as drafted, recommends itself as a source document for the generation of policy and administrative decisions respecting utility expansion for future growth,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED,

That the City of Stayton Master Utilities Plan is hereby adopted as a working tool in the formation of utility construction policy and in aiding the design and development of public works facilities. Given the flexible nature of the document, the Master Utilities Plan is adopted as a guide, and not as a standard, and thus will serve as a basis for the exercise of discretion and not a statement of commitment.
