

RESOLUTION NUMBER 104

Ordering paving of S.W. corner of the intersection of First Avenue and Ida Street belonging to Raymond C. and Ida M. Equall, 1053 Long Street, Woodburn, Oregon.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that the S.W. corner of the intersection of First Avenue and Ida Street, which is more specifically described as that tract of land described in volume 543 page 15 deed records from Marion County, Oregon, be improved by paving with asphaltic concrete to a width of 10 feet from the curb line to the edge of the existing pavement from First Avenue to a point 116 feet from the west line of First Avenue.

The total cost of said improvement shall be levied upon the property especially benefitted thereby, as provided by the Charter of the City of Stayton. Such paving shall be completed within 90 days from the date of mailing of notice by the city recorder to the owner of said property of the adoption of this resolution. The recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to improve the street as herein ordered. Before improving such street, the owner shall consult the city engineer as to the type of asphalt and material to be used and the specifications therefore.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the street improvement as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such street improvement and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved.
