

RESOLUTION NO. 149

WHEREAS, the expenses of operation of the City of Stayton have increased because of increased administrative costs and the necessity to expand the Police, Fire, Library, and Park budgets, and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary by the common council that the six per cent limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution be exceeded in order to raise necessary funds for the operation of the City, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that a special City election be and hereby is called for the purpose of presenting to the registered voters of the City for their approval or rejection an increased tax levy in the amount of \$16,255.08 over the 6% limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, of the Oregon Constitution, and,

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the polls for such election be open from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 30, 1970, and that the polling place be the City Hall, 362 N. 3rd, Stayton. and,

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the ballot title be substantially as follows:

Shall the City Council of the City of Stayton, Oregon be authorized to levy for the operation of the City during the fiscal year 1970-71 the sum of \$16,255.08 in taxes over the amount limited by the Oregon Constitution, for a maximum levy rate of 73 cents per \$1000 of true cash value of taxable property within the City?

and that the City recorder shall cause notice of such election to be given by publication in the Stayton Mail and by posting and cause the necessary ballots to be printed and supplies furnished for said election.
