

RESOLUTION NUMBER 162

ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF STORM SEWERS ALONG
GARDNER AVENUE FROM THE NORTH SIDE OF
LOCUST STREET TO THE SOUTH SIDE
OF SHAFF ROAD.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that Gardener Avenue from the North side of Locust Street to the South side of Shaff Road, within the City of Stayton, be improved by construction of a storm sewer drainage system along both sides of said Avenue.


The storm sewers ordered constructed by this resolution shall be built according to the specifications of the City Engineer and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved. Such storm sewer system shall be completed within sixty (60) days after engineering data is available and notice is given to the owners.

The Recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to construct a storm sewer as herein ordered; and in case the address of the owner be unknown, the City Engineer shall post such notice upon said property. Before constructing such storm sewer, the owner of said premises or his agent shall obtain plans and specifications from the City Engineer, which shall prescribe the kind of storm sewer to be constructed, the material to be used and specifications therefor.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the storm sewer as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the


construction of such improvements and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved.
