

WHEREAS, THE STATE OF OREGON, acting by and through its State Highway Commission, has caused to be prepared and submitted to the CITY OF

STAYTON an agreement providing for the improvement of
Locust Street from ^{First} ~~First~~ Avenue to ^{760 feet West} ~~N. Douglas Avenue~~

within the said City, by the terms of which agreement the State is to pay the costs, excepting concrete curbs, not to exceed \$25,000 and the City is to pay the total cost of concrete curbs and any additional costs in excess of \$25,000 as its share of the total cost of such improvement; and

WHEREAS, said agreement as submitted has been read in full to the Council of said City and approved as submitted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Stayton that the Mayor and Recorder are hereby directed and authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of said City.
