

RESOLUTION NUMBER 176

ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ON PORTIONS OF THE FOLLOWING NAMED STREETS: EAST VIRGINIA STREET, WEST VIRGINIA STREET, EAST BURNETTE STREET, NORTH SECOND AVENUE, EAST HOLLISTER STREET, EAST IDA STREET, AND EAST HIGH STREET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council, pursuant to Chapter IX of the Stayton City Charter, hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that East Virginia Street from First Avenue to the west line of Potter's Addition; East Burnette Street from First Avenue to Fourth Avenue; and North Second Avenue from Hollister Street to Cedar Street be improved by the construction of a curb and four foot sidewalk along both sides of said streets; and that East Hollister Street from First Avenue to Third Avenue be improved by the construction of a curb and four foot sidewalk along the north side of said street and a five foot curb sidewalk along the south side of said street; and that East High Street from First Avenue to Third Avenue be improved by the construction of a curb and four foot sidewalk along both sides of said street except that a ten foot curb sidewalk be constructed on the south side of said street from Second Avenue to a point one hundred feet West of Second Avenue and on the north side of said street from First Avenue to a point fifty feet East of First Avenue; and that East Ida Street from Third Avenue to Fourth Avenue be improved by the construction of a ten foot curb sidewalk along both sides of said street.

The curbs and sidewalks ordered constructed by this resolution shall be built of Portland cement concrete as provided by Ordinance NO. 300 and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved. The curbs and sidewalks shall be completed within 60 days after engineering data is available and notice is given to the owners.

The Recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to construct a curb and sidewalk as herein ordered; and in case the address of the owner be unknown, the City Engineer shall post such notice upon said property. Before constructing such curbs and sidewalks, the owner of said premises or his agent shall obtain plans and specifications from the City Engineer, which shall prescribe the kind of curbs and sidewalks to be constructed, the materials to be used and specifications therefor.


In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the curbs and sidewalks as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such improvements and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved.
