

RESOLUTION NO. 45

TRAFFIC SIGNS AT 10TH STREET AND MEHAMA ROAD

WHEREAS the movement of northbound traffic without stopping through the intersection at 10th Street and Mehama Road, Stayton, Oregon, creates a hazard for both the westbound and northbound traffic, and

WHEREAS a view of westbound traffic is denied to northbound traffic at this intersection by obstructions in the form of buildings and trees, and


WHEREAS the arrangement of the roadway at this intersection is such that no hazard is created by northbound traffic which turns east on Mehama Road at this intersection, therefor

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that installation of traffic signs be authorized at the intersection of 10th Street and Mehama Road reading "STOP" and "RIGHT TURN PERMITTED WITHOUT STOPPING" to control traffic entering this intersection from the south on 10th Street.
