

1 RESOLUTION NO. 55

2 A RESOLUTION PROPOSING AND INITIATING AN AMENDMENT OF THE
3 CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON, OREGON, AMENDING CHAPTER 1, Section
4 1 OF CHARTER RELATING TO THE NAME OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON: PROVID-
5 ING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF SUCH AMENDMENT TO TO VOTERS OF THE TOWN
6 OF STAYTON AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 18th DAY
7 OF MAY, 1962.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON,
9 OREGON.

10 Section 1. That the common council does hereby propose an
11 amendment to Chapter 1, Section 1 of the Charter of the Town of
12 Stayton; said amendment relating to the name of the Town of Stayton.

13 Section 2. That the amendment of Chapter 1, Section 1. of
14 the Charter of the Town of Stayton, Oregon is hereby initiated and
15 proposed and shall read as follows, to-wit:

16 "AN ACT to amend the Charter of the Town of Stayton,
17 Oregon, by amending Chapter 1, Section 1 providing and
18 relating to the Name of Town of Stayton.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON, OREGON
20 Chapter 1, Section 1., That the inhabitants of the Town of Stayton,
21 Marion County, Oregon and their successors withing the following
22 limits are hereby declared a body politic and corporate, by name
23 and style of "City of Stayton".

24 Section 3. The city attorney is hereby instructed and direct-
25 ed to prepare the necessary heading and ballot title under which the
26 act for the proposed amendment to the Charter of the Town of Stayton
27 shall be submitted to the legal voters of said Town.

28 Section 4. The charter amendment initiated and proposed by
29 this resolution shall be submitted to the legal voters of said Town
30 of Stayton, Oregon at the primary election to be held on the 18th
31 day of May, 1962.

32 Section 5. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance
are such to affect the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants
of the Town of Stayton, Oregon an emergency is hereby declared to
exist and this resolution shall be and become effective upon its

1 passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
