

RESOLUTION NO. 84

Authorizing filing of application with the Regional Park and Recreation Agency of the Mid Willamette Valley for an advance to provide for the planning and development of parks in the City of Stayton.

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton, after thorough consideration of the various aspects of the problem and study of available data has hereby determined that a need exists for the development of the old park facilities. Such development would include the plowing, leveling, rolling, filling, fertilizing, reseeding, paving of paths and installation of a sprinkler system. This project is desirable and in the public interest and to that end it is necessary that action preliminary to development be taken immediately; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Park and Recreation Agency of the Mid Willamette Valley has authorized the making of advances to public bodies to aid in financing the cost of park and recreation development; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has examined and duly considered such authorization and the applicant considers it to be in the public interest and to its benefit to file an application under said authorization and to authorized other action in connection therewith;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council, the governing body of said applicant, as follows:

1. That the development of said park is essential to and is to the best interests of the applicant, and to the end that such public park may be provided as promptly as practicable;
2. That Merlin L. Morey, Mayor, be hereby authorized to file in behalf of the applicant an application for an advance to aid in defraying the cost of development;
3. That if such advance be made, the applicant shall provide or make necessary arrangements to provide such funds, in addition to the advance, as may be required to defray the cost of the development of such park;
4. That Patricia Meyn, Councilwoman, is hereby authorized to furnish such information and take such action as may be necessary to enable the applicant to qualify for the advance;
5. That the officer designated in the preceding paragraph is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the applicant for the purpose of furnishing such information, data and documents pertaining to the application for an advance as may be required; and otherwise to act as the authorized representative of the applicant in connection with this application;
6. That certified copies of this resolution be included as part of the application for an advance to be submitted to the Regional Park and Recreation Agency.
