Julia Hajduk, current Community Development Director and past Planning Manager for the City of Sherwood, has 15 years of local government management experience. She has also served as a City of Sherwood Senior Planner, City of Tigard Associate Planner, City of Springfield Planner, and Economic Development Assistant at the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments. She received her bachelor's degree in Geography from Western Oregon University. Ms. Hajduk says, "I am extremely pleased to be a finalist for the City Manager position and look forward to meeting the community members and staff throughout the interview process. I look forward to sharing how my experiences and background will make me a great asset to Stayton and to hear how I can help you meet the community's needs and aspirations."



Daniel Hunter, current Human Resources Director and Risk Manager for the City of The Dalles, has 6 years of local government management experience. He has also served as a Project Coordinator and Administrative Fellow for the City of The Dalles, Motor Carrier Enforcement Officer and Bridge Deck Inspector/Road Rater for the Montana Department of Transportation. Mr. Hunter holds a Master of Public Administration from American Military University and a bachelor's degree in Political Science from Linfield College. He is a veteran having proudly served in the US Air Force. Mr. Hunter says, "My Interest in city management began over twenty years ago while attending Clackamas Community College. As a native Oregonian my hope is that my career would be managing a City in

Oregon. Stayton is a special place both because of its history and its proximity to recreation for those of us who love the outdoors."

Matthew "Selby" Selby, current Interim Assistant City Manager for the City of Yakima, WA, has 11 years of local government management experience.
