## KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 48.55 million gallons were treated during April. The highest

Daily flow was 2.40 million gallons on the 1st and the lowest flow was 1.18 million gallons on the 26th. The average flow was 1.62 million gallons. Total rainfall for April was 2.40 inches. 26.41 dry tons of bio solids were produced.

9.75 cubic yards of bio solids were hauled off site in April.

WTP Highest production day was 2,723,000 gallons on April 16th.

Water System Replaced 4 water meters and 1 meter box. Repaired a water line at 510 E

Cedar. Flushed 65 hydrants using 127,000 gallons of water.

Streets Swept 135 curb miles and 12 cubic yards of material was collected. 1,020 lbs. of

cold mix and 3 yards of gravel were applied to street potholes and street

cutouts. Replaced seven stop signs.
