SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- April 2021

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 36.40 million gallons were treated during April. The highest

Daily flow was 1.47 million gallons on April 1st, and the lowest flow was 0.99 million gallons on the 25th. The average flow was 1.21 million gallons. Total rainfall for April was 0.74 inches. 10 yards of Santiam Green biosolids were given

away, and 100.5 yards were used on City property in April.

WTP Highest production day was 2,280,000 gallons on April 16th.

• Water System Replaced 4 water meters.

• Streets Swept 135 curb miles and 25 cubic yards of material was collected. Replaced 2

regulatory signs, 1 stop sign, and painted 120 linear feet of yellow curb.

6th.
