SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- April 2022

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 59.34 million gallons were treated during April. The highest Daily flow was 2.78 million gallons on the 14th and the lowest flow was 1.21 million gallons on the 3rd. The average flow was 1.98 million gallons. Total rainfall for April was 6.76 inches. 4 Yards bio solids were hauled off site in April.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,066,000 gallons on April 08, 2022.
- **Water System** Replaced 7 water meters. Replaced 2 meter boxes and 2 water service lines.
- **Streets** Swept 138 curb miles and 13 cubic yards of material was collected. 10 cubic yards of sweeping material hauled off to Coffin Butte.
- **Parks** None for April 2022.
