## **KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS**

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 59.34 million gallons were treated during April. The

highest Daily flow was 2.78 million gallons on the 14th and the lowest flow was 1.21 million gallons on the 3<sup>rd</sup>. The average flow was 1.98 million gallons. Total rainfall for April was 6.76 inches. 4 Yards bio

solids were hauled off site in April.

WTP Highest production day was 3,066,000 gallons on April 08, 2022.

• Water System Replaced 7 water meters. Replaced 2 meter boxes and 2 water service lines.

Streets Swept 138 curb miles and 13 cubic yards of material was collected. 10 cubic

yards of sweeping material hauled off to Coffin Butte.
