KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

WWTP Facility

Effluent flows: 32.92 million gallons were treated during August. The highest Daily flow was 1.72 million gallons on the 27th (during Basin #1 take down), 1.63 million gallons on August 1st (during Basin #2 take down)and the lowest flow was 0.63 million gallons on the 15th. The average flow was 1.06 million gallons. Total rainfall for August was 0.46 inches. Biosolids produced were 30.61 dry tons and 3 yards of Biosolids were given away in August and zero - 5 gallon buckets.

WTP

Highest production day was 6,438,000 gallons on August 24, 2019.

Water System

Cleaned water filter beds 2 & 3. Moved meters for better access at 306 Shaff Rd and 397 Fourth Ave. Repaired a meter stop at 2175 Kindle Way. Replaced 15 meters and repaired one meter.

Streets

177 curb miles swept and 85 cubic yards of material was removed from the streets. 660 lbs. of cold mix was applied. 1 yard of gravel was applied to gravel roads. 33 traffic signs replaced. 2,289 feet of yellow curb painted. 2,086 feet of white striping was applied which included parking stalls, speed bumps, crosswalks, stop bars, etc.
