SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- August 2021

## KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

- WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 34.41 million gallons were treated during August. The highest Daily flow was 1.36 million gallons on the 9th and the lowest flow was 0.88 million gallons on the 7th. The average flow was 1.11 million gallons. Total rainfall for August was 0.00 inches. 1 yard of Santiam Green bio-solids were given away in August.
- WTP Highest production day was 3,695,000 gallons on August 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Water System Replaced 11 water meters. Replaced one service line.
- Streets Swept 124 curb miles and 12 cubic yards of material was collected. Replaced 1 stop sign and painted 910 ft of yellow curb.
- Parks None for August 2021.
