SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- August 2022

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

- WWTP Facility WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 33.91million gallons were treated during August. The highest Daily flow was 1.31 million gallons on the 2nd and 10th and the lowest flow was 0.89 million gallons on the 1st. The average flow was 1.09 million gallons. Total rainfall was 0 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in August.
- WTP Highest production day was 3,713,000 gallons on August 13, 2022.
- Water System Replaced 18 meters. Replaced 2 meter boxes. Repaired 1 meter stop. We repaired a sink hole at Western Pl and Westown Dr.
- Streets Swept 131 curb miles and 12 cubic yards of material was collected.
- Parks None for August 2022.
