SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- December 2020

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 71.00 million gallons were treated during December. The

highest Daily flow was 5.36 million gallons on December 21st and the lowest flow was 1.31 million gallons on the 5th. The average flow was 2.29 million gallons. Total rainfall for December was 8.67 inches. 2 yards of Santiam Green

were hauled off site in December.

• WTP Highest production day was 2,722,000 gallons on December 11th.

Water System Replaced 3 water meters and 1 radio reader. Water service repair at 1475

Second Ave. Cleaned number 3 slow sand filter bed.

Streets
Swept 135 curb miles and 35 cubic yards of material was collected. Collected 60

cubic yards of material for fall cleanup. 360 lbs of food and \$45.00 were

donated to the food bank.
