## **KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS**

• **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 98.27 million gallons were treated during December. The highest

Daily flow was 7.04 million gallons on the 20<sup>th</sup> and the lowest flow was 1.58 million gallons on the 5<sup>th</sup>. The average flow was 3.17 million gallons. Total rainfall for December was 15.34 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in

December.

WTP Highest production day was 2,726,000 gallons on December 18<sup>th</sup>.

• Water System Replaced 1 water meter.

• Streets Filled numerous potholes on gravel roads. Applied 8 loads of sand to the roads

during snowstorm.
