• **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 64.92 million gallons were treated during December. The highest

Daily flow was 4.15 million gallons on the 28th and the lowest flow was 1.46 million gallons on the 18th. The average flow was 1.93 million gallons. Total rainfall for December was 7.78 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in

December.

WTP Highest production day was 3,493,000 gallons on December 07, 2022.

• Water System Replaced 6 meters. Repaired 1 meter stop and replaced 1 meter box.

• Streets Swept 425 curb miles and 74 cubic yards of material was collected.
