## KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 77.93 million gallons were treated during February. The highest

Daily flow was 5.34 million gallons on February 14<sup>th</sup> and the lowest flow was 1.98 million gallons on the 10<sup>th</sup>. The average flow was 2.78 million gallons. Total rainfall for February was 7.36 inches. No Santiam Green biosolids were hauled

off site in February.

WTP Highest production day was 3,065,000 gallons on February 12<sup>th</sup>.
