• **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 43.19 million gallons were treated during February. The highest

Daily flow was \sim 1.76 million gallons on the 28th and the lowest flow was 1.20 million gallons on the 4th. The average flow was 1.45 million gallons. Total rainfall for February was 3.38 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in

February.

• WTP Highest production day was 3,439,000 gallons on February 8, 2023.

• Water System Replaced 2 meters. Replaced 2 meter boxes and replaced 1 water service line.

• Streets Swept 25 curb miles and 16 cubic yards of material was collected.
