SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- January 2020

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

- WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 78.63 million gallons were treated during January. The highest Daily flow was 3.72 million gallons on the 29th and the lowest flow was 1.35 million gallons on the 3rd. The average flow was 2.43 million gallons. Total rainfall for January was 10.67 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in January. Biosolids produced were 25.30 dry tons.
- WTP Highest production day was 2,462,000 gallons on January 30th.
- Water System Replaced 5 meters. 5 meter boxes were either replaced or brought up to grade. Repaired a water service line near 1402 Dawn Drive and service line on Jetters Way.
- Streets Swept 156 curb miles and 33 cubic yards of debris was removed. Applied 720 lbs of cold mix and 1 yard of gravel to streets. Replaced two street name signs, one regulatory sign and one stop sign.
- **Parks** Parks Board: Total # of Volunteers = 6, Total # of hours = 36
