KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 87.03 million gallons were treated during January. The highest

Daily flow was 4.83 million gallons on January 13th and the lowest flow was 1.87 million gallons on the 23rd. The average flow was 2.81 million gallons. Total rainfall for January was 9.26 inches. 1.5 yards of Santiam Green were hauled off

site in January.

WTP Highest production day was 3,065,000 gallons on January 12th.

Water System Replaced 4 water meters, 2 meter boxes, and 31 radio readers. Water service

repairs at 645 N Evergreen, 1178 N Third, 308 E Water, and 366 E Water St.

Streets
Swept 165 curb miles and 34 cubic yards of material was collected. Replaced 1

30" stop sign.
