SUBJECT:	Public Works Monthly Operating Report- January 2022	

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

- WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 76.35 million gallons were treated during January. The highest Daily flow was 4.9 million gallons on the 6th and the lowest flow was 1.43 million gallons on the 30th. The average flow was 2.46 million gallons. Total rainfall for January was 4.90 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in January.
- WTP Highest production day was 3,185,000 gallons on January 26, 2022.
- Water System Replaced 10 water meters. Installed 2 new meters with radio reader and replaced 1 radio reader.
- Streets Swept 159 curb miles and 30 cubic yards of material was collected. Replaced 2 regulatory signs.
- Parks None for January 2022.
