SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- July 2019

## KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

- WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 30.79 million gallons were treated during July. The highest Daily flow was 1.40 million gallons on the 1st and the lowest flow was 0.79 million gallons on the 25<sup>th</sup>. The average flow was 0.99 million gallons. Total rainfall for July was 0.39 inches. Biosolids produced were 19.46 Dry Tons and 2 yards of Biosolids were given away in July as well as (15) 5 gallon buckets.
- WTP Highest production day was 6,365,000 gallons on July 13, 2019.
- Water System Replaced 11 water meters and repaired one meter. One new meter installed with a radio reader. Replaced meter stop at 240 Noble Ave.
- Streets 112 curb miles swept and 34 CY of material was removed from the streets. 840 lbs. of cold mix was applied. 40 yds. of gravel was applied to gravel roads along with 5,743 gallons of dust control.
