KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: Effluent flows: 34.67 million gallons were treated during July.

The highest Daily flow was 1.37 million gallons on the 22nd and the lowest flow was 0.90 million gallons on the 11th. The average flow was 1.12 million gallons. Total rainfall for July was 0.02 inches. 196 yards of bio-solids were given away in

July.

WTP Highest production day was 4,073,000 gallons on July 24th.

• Water System Replaced 11 water meters. Cleaned number 1 filter bed.

• Streets Swept 125 curb miles and 16 cubic yards of material was collected. Replaced 9

regulatory and 1 guide signs.

• Parks None for July 2021.
