## **KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS**

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 35.81 million gallons were treated during July. The highest Daily

flow was 1.39 million gallons on the 6th and the lowest flow was 0.99 million gallons on the 17<sup>th</sup>. The average flow was 1.16 million gallons. Total rainfall for

July was 0.26 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in July.

• WTP Highest production day was 3,600,000 gallons on July 26, 2022.

Water System

Streets

Replaced 4 meters. Replaced 3 meter boxes and 1 service line. Repaired 2 water main. We repaired two leaks on Fern Ridge and replaced the service on  $6^{\rm th}$  Ave.

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Swept 118 curb miles and 17 cubic yards of material was collected. 10 cubic yards of sweeping material hauled off to Coffin Butte.
