KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 39.07 million gallons were treated during June. The highest

Daily flow was 1.64 million gallons on the 16th and the lowest flow was 1.05 million gallons on the 28th. The average flow was 1.30 million gallons. Total rainfall for June was 2.87 inches. 23.29 dry tons of bio solids were produced. 17

yards of bio solids were hauled off site in June.

WTP Highest production day was 3,084,000 gallons on June 4th.

Water System
Replaced 4 water meters. Water line repairs at 1228 and 1254 Kent Ct. Flushed

four fire hydrants.

Streets Swept 145 curb miles and 20 cubic yards of material was collected. 1,200 lbs. of

cold mix and 2 yards of gravel were applied to street potholes and street

cutouts. Replaced one Warning street sign.
