SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- June 2023

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 34.54 million gallons were treated during June. The highest Daily

flow was .97 million gallons on the 4th and the lowest flow was 0.82 million gallons on the 24th. The average flow was 0.89 million gallons. Total rainfall for

June was .44 inches. 270.25 Yards of biosolids were applied onsite.

• WTP Highest production day was 3,507,000 gallons on June 02, 2023.

• Water System Replaced 29 meters. Replaced 21 meter boxes and 21 water service lines.

Streets Swept 40 curb miles and 15 cubic yards of material was collected.
