• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 64.98 million gallons were treated during March. The highest

Daily flow was 4.55 million gallons on the 1st and the lowest flow was 1.3 million gallons on the 26th. The average flow was 2.02 million gallons. Total

rainfall was 3.68 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site.

WTP Highest production day was 3,750,000 gallons on March 7, 2024.

• Water System Replaced 5 meters. Replaced 1 meter box.

• Streets Swept 130 curb miles with 19 cubic yards of material removed from the streets.
