SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- May 2019

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 38.18 million gallons were treated during May. The highest Daily

flow was 1.49 million gallons on the 6th and the lowest flow was 1.04 million gallons on the 25th. The average flow was 1.23 million gallons. Total rainfall for May was 1.92 inches. 7 yards of Santiam Green was loaded into a customer's

trailer and 5 - 5 gallon buckets were given out as well in May.

• WTP Highest production day was 2,951,000 gallons on May 8, 2019. 3,900 tons of

new sand was delivered to slow sand filter bed #1 in May.

Water System Installed one new meter and radio reader. Replaced 32 meters, 21 meters were

replaced for the Regis Street project. Replaced water services at 1860 Evergreen Ave, 1482 & 1472 Fifth Ct, and at 1215 N Third Ave. Repaired a water service at 165 S. First Ave. Repaired a water main on Kathy St. Replaced four

valve boxes on Regis St.

• Streets Gravel was spread & compacted on the shoulder of E Burnett St & Seventh Ave.

Cold patch applied throughout town including High St, Ida St, Fourth Ave and

Jefferson St.
