SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- May 2020

## KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 39.49 million gallons were treated during May. The highest Daily

flow was 1.5 million gallons on the 19th and the lowest flow was 1.03 million gallons on the 10th. The average flow was 1.27 million gallons. Total rainfall for May was 3.88 inches. 22.81 dry tons of bio solids were produced. 39.33 yards of

bio solids were hauled off site in May.

• WTP Highest production day was 3,105,000 gallons on May 27th.

Water System Replaced 3 water meters and 2 meter boxes. Cleaned water filter bed #3.

Water line repair at 1163 Westwood. Water line repair at 872 Maple. Water line repair at the corner of Fern and Ida. Completed the hydrant flushing in May,

with another 70 hydrants and 124,200 gallons of Water.

• Streets Swept 124 curb miles and 18 cubic yards of material was collected. 300 lbs. of

cold mix and 9 yards of gravel were applied to street potholes and street

cutouts. Replaced 12 streets signs.
