SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- May 2021

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: Effluent flows: 33.91 million gallons were treated during May.

The highest Daily flow was 1.29 million gallons on the 3rd and 10th and the lowest flow was 0.86 million gallons on the 30th. The average flow was 1.09 million gallons. Total rainfall for May was 2.06 inches. 5 Yards bio solids were given to Citizens in May. 123 Yards were spread on City owned Property for

beneficial use in May.

WTP Highest production day was 2,863,000 gallons on May 6th.

Water System Replaced 8 water meters and 2 meter boxes.

Streets
Swept 128 curb miles and 20 cubic yards of material was collected. Replaced 1

regulatory sign, 5 street name signs, and 2 no parking signs.
