SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- November 2021

## KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

- WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 60.75 million gallons were treated during November. The highest Daily flow was 3.88 million gallons on the 12<sup>th</sup> and the lowest flow was 1.46 million gallons on the 2<sup>nd</sup> The average flow was 2.03 million gallons. Total rainfall for November was 7.31 inches. 0 yards of Santiam Green bio-solids were given away in November.
- WTP Highest production day was 2,937,000 gallons on November 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Water System Replaced 22 water meters.
- Streets Swept 392 curb miles and 138 cubic yards of material was collected. Replaced 5 Stop signs
- Parks None for November 2021.
