**SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- October 2019**

**KEY ACTIVITIES**

**STATUS**

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 34.71 million gallons were treated during October. The highest Daily flow was 1.17 million gallons on the 19th and the lowest flow was 0.88 million gallons on the 31<sup>st</sup>. The average flow was 0.98 million gallons. Total rainfall for October was 2.73 inches. 6 Yards bio solids were hauled off site in October.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,580,000 gallons on October 12, 2019.
- **Water System** Replaced 13 meters. Replaced an angle meter stop at 595 E Washington St. Replaced the hydrant at Third and Marion and replaced the hydrant at 205 N First Ave. Both hydrants were damaged by motor vehicles.
- **Streets** Swept 410 miles and collected 185 cubic yards of material. Used 240 pounds of cold patch to repair potholes around town.
- **Parks** Parks Board: Total # of Volunteers = 6, Total # of hours = 33
