SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- October 2021

## KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

- WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 37.68 million gallons were treated during October. The highest Daily flow was 1.53 million gallons on the 26th and the lowest flow was 0.94 million gallons on the 17th. The average flow was 1.21 million gallons. Total rainfall for October was 5.41 inches. 8.75 yards of Santiam Green bio-solids were given away in October.
- WTP Highest production day was 2,744,000 gallons on October 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Water System Replaced 6 water meters. Replaced one service line.
- Streets Swept 337 curb miles and 83 cubic yards of material was collected.
- Parks None for October 2021.
