KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

WWTP Facility

Effluent flows: 34.34 million gallons were treated during September. The highest Daily flow was 1.52 million gallons on the 28th and the lowest flow was 0.92 million gallons on the 5th and 12th. The average flow was 1.14 million gallons. Total rainfall for September was 3.60 inches. 43 yards of Santiam Green bio-solids were given away in September by the middle of the month and we ran out.

WTP Highest production day was 3,787,000 gallons on September 22nd.

Water System

Replaced 13 water meters. Replaced 1 meter box. Repaired 1 meter box. Repaired 2 water mains. Replaced 2 service lines.

Streets

Swept 125 curb miles and 17 cubic yards of material was collected.

Parks

None for September 2021.
