KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

• WWTP Facility

Effluent flows: 61.84 million gallons were treated during April. The highest flow was 2.79 million gallons on the 16th and the lowest flow was 1.48 million gallons on the 28th & 29th. The average flow was 2.06 million gallons. Total rainfall for April was 6.05 inches. Repaired 2 leaking manholes & placed 4 pipe patches on Wilco Road.

WTP Highest production day was 1,975,000 gallons on April 9, 2018.

Water System

Replaced 5 meters. Installed 4 new meters with radio readers. Replaced a water service on Evergreen. Installed a 1 ½ inch meter service for the Community Garden. Also installed the water service for 15 plots at the Community Garden. Repaired a water service at 1820 Green Acres Court.

Streets

Swept 240 curb miles and collected 40 cubic yards of material. 69.7 tons of debris collected from street sweeping was hauled off to Coffin Butte. Right-of-ways mowed. A total of 4 crosswalks, 181 feet of yellow curb, 6 parking "L's", 8 parking "T's", and 2 handicap stalls were striped.
