SUBJECT: December Library report

In December, all Library staff helped open our Wreath Lab, and 108 people of all ages joined us over two sessions to make a holiday wreath of their own. Forty-four people joined Jennifer, Kim, Nicole, and Shelby in December for a special winter-themed storytime at Hiatt Christmas Tree Farm in Sublimity. Stephanie provided hot cider to everyone, and Christian joined us to take pictures. We gave away free books to all children at the event thanks to funding from the Abigail Scott Duniway Chapter of the DAR.

Evie facilitated a teen meetup and volunteer opportunity, and ten of our teen volunteers came to decorate cookies and collaborate on Stephanie's ornament project. Jennifer and Janna provided free books to all children at Stayton Elementary School's caroling event, and Jennifer provided stories as well. Rachel hosted a Dungeons & Dragons session for teens and adults. Rachel and Shelby presented family-friendly Victorian ghost stories, cookies, and cocoa at our Spirits of Christmas program, and Stephanie and Janna hosted a Victorian ornament craft station.

Twenty-six people of all ages joined Stephanie, Shelby, Nicole, and Janna to make string Christmas trees at our DIY Craftshop program. The community helped us create a holiday light map, highlighting houses and neighborhoods with festive lights. It was accessed over 700 times as community members toured through neighborhoods lit for the season.

Evie hosted our Holiday Party, and all Library staff helped celebrate our volunteers, Friends of the Library, Library Board, and Library Foundation board members. One hundred and thirty-one people of all ages came to help us light the Library and the path in the park with lights and lanterns. Operation Re-Home the Gnomes: our Winter Reading Challenge started and will continue through January 31. To participate, people hunt for the gnomes hiding in the Library and complete challenges to earn a prize.

All-Star Preschool brought a class to the Library on a field trip. Jennifer, Evie, Janna, and Kim provided stories and tours. Jennifer represented us at the PYM (Polk, Yamhill, and Marion counties) Children's Services meeting.
