SUBJECT: September Library report

In September, new sessions of Family Storytime and Toddler Time started. On Tuesdays, children, parents, and caregivers joined Jennifer and Kim to explore the world of early literacy through songs and rhythms, stories, and rhymes at Family Storytime. Toddler Time is on Wednesdays. Jennifer designed it for parents to explore the world of early learning and literacy together with their infant or toddler through different activities and stations for play, including the Infant Zone, specifically designed for not-yet-mobile learners.

Adults met for Book Club with Stephanie to discuss *Dear Edward* by Ann Napolitano. Rachel hosted a session of Dungeons & Dragons for teens and adults. Jennifer and Evie opened the Readers Café, and children and family members joined them to "taste" some children's titles, explore new book options and take home a book of their choice to keep. Over a hundred children unleashed their inner builder at our LEGO Build It program, available for an hour every afternoon for a week. Jennifer, Stephanie, and Janna ran our Craft Together program, and participants created stamps with clay and made botanical prints. The program was designed to provide an opportunity for children to craft with their grown-ups and also to include teens and adults crafting independently. Library staff and community members celebrated the Stayton Friends of the Library and their contributions to the Stayton Public Library with a party.

Janna is the chair of the Polk, Yamhill, and Marion County Library Directors this year, led their meeting and attended the CCRLS Advisory Council meeting. Evie represented Stayton at the PYM Circulation Committee meeting.
