SUBJECT: February Library report

In February, eighty-nine people attended our Teddy Bear Tea Party. Children, their grown-ups, and their favorite stuffed animals enjoyed tea, snacks, and an activity. Thank you to the Stayton Public Library Foundation for sponsoring the event and to our amazing staff and volunteers who made it possible!

Our 5th Annual Art Show featuring works of local artists was held in the Library throughout February. Eighty people joined Stephanie and Janna at its opening reception. Rachel hosted a Dungeons and Dragons game for first-timers or experienced players ages 12 and up. Jennifer and Janna opened the STEAM Lab for an hour every afternoon for a week, and children created different kinds of bird feeders. Thirty people of all ages joined Stephanie and Janna to make paper roses at our DIY Craftshop program. Adults met for Book Club with Stephanie to discuss *The Mystery of Mrs. Christie* by Marie Benedict. AARP Tax Aides assisted people with their taxes at the Library by appointment every Wednesday. They will be here through tax season.

We hosted Head Start's Parent Night. Jennifer presented at it, and Janna helped with tours. Janna ran the CCRLS Polk, Yamhill and Marion County (PYM) Library Directors meeting and attended the state-wide Library Directors meeting. Jennifer represented us at the PYM Children's Services meeting.
