Over 110 people attended the Library Foundation's Brews, Bites, & Books event. Thank you to all our event partners! Three Creeks Brewing Company presented the craft beer. La Esperanza Mexican Bakery & Restaurant, Moxieberry, Baked and Loaded Potatoes, Trexler Farm, Panezanellie Breadstick Shoppe, and The Lovin' Oven supplied the local bites. Rising Star Studios provided live music, Young Mobile Entertainment provided sound and lighting, and What the Quirk, Vintage Emporium loaned us vintage glassware. It was a fantastic event. Many thanks to all those who attended.

The Library hosted Oregon author R. Gregory Nokes. His book, *The Troubled Life of Peter Burnett: Oregon Pioneer and First Governor of California* is the first biography written about Burnett, a talented, but deeply flawed leader in the early American West.

Almost 100 children came and received a free book on Martin Luther King Jr. Day. Kids also built and raced lego cars, celebrated national Rubber Ducky day and had a Penguin Party. Teens tried to survive the Oregon Trail in a life-size version of the iconic computer game.
