In January, Jennifer split our weekly storytime into two sessions, toddler storytime and preschool storytime. The move has successfully allowed Jennifer to tailor the content and activities to be more age-specific and helped manage our growing program attendance. Jennifer also added a monthly sensory storytime and a family storytime on the first Saturday of the month.

The Oregon Shadow Theatre presented Jack and the Dragon. The fairytale was presented with colorful shadow puppets and live banjo and hammer dulcimer music. Afterwards, the performers invited children from the audience to explore the instruments and shadow puppet process.

More than 180 children and parents came to the Library to celebrate Martin Luther King Jr.'s Birthday, and we gave free books to over 100 children. Stuffed animals were invited to spend the night in the Library as part of January's Pajama Storytime. Children made pillows for their stuffed animals, had storytime and a snack with them and then tucked them in for a night in the Library. They picked up the stuffed animals the next day and got to see the pictures of the mischief the animals got into overnight.

Stephanie put out a call for local art for the Library's 3rd Annual Art Show. Over 70 people came to the opening reception. The art will be up in the Library throughout February. Adults made glitter wine glasses and teens made perler bead creations. Rachel added a second Dungeons and Dragons session to teach beginning players to build their own characters.

The Stayton Public Library Foundation held our annual Brews, Bites and Books event. During the event week, Wolfgang's Thirst Parlor Tap House partnered with the Library Foundation for a pint night fundraiser. Three Creeks Brewing presented the craft beer for Brews, Bites and Books. Local bites were supplied by La Esperanza Mexican Bakery and Restaurant, Baked & Loaded Potatoes, Panezanellie Breadstick Shoppe, Trexler Farm and The Lovin' Oven. Bob
