SUBJECT: January Library report

January started with a reduction in the Library's service levels due to a cut in staffing and materials following the local option levy's failure. Curbside times were adjusted to try to serve as many patrons as possible with less staff.

Throughout the month, people of all ages participated in our Winter Reading Challenge. It included opportunities to read, listen, and explore library resources as well as a shadow box hunt to find clues in the windows of downtown businesses. Many thanks to the businesses who hosted our shadow boxes. Jennifer started Book Bistro To Go boxes for children. Each month children will get a selection of books to get "a taste" of a new genre and some surprise extras. Forty-five children received boxes in January.

We transitioned take and make kit pick up to a drive-thru event following our success with that model in December. Kits included: DIY fairy lights and growing salt crystals for children, fizzy bath bombs for teens and soy candles for adults. The instructions for each project were posted on the Library website so people who were unable to get kits could still complete the projects with their own supplies.

While AARP Tax Aides are unable to staff a tax assistance program at the Library this year due to the pandemic, they have partnered with us to continue to connect as many people as possible to resources and assistance with their taxes this season. We are grateful for their volunteers and their dedicated commitment to our community.
