SUBJECT: January Library report

In January, one hundred eighty participants hunted for the gnomes hiding in the Library and completed their challenges to earn a prize for Operation Re-Home the Gnomes: our Winter Reading Challenge. Library staff wrote the mystery and designed the décor and logistics of Withdrawn: a 1920s Murder Mystery fundraising event for the Library Foundation. The fundraiser was a great success! Thank you to Julia, Mayor Quigley, Councilor Ohrt and Councilor Patty for attending. We want to give a special shout-out to Chief Johns for appearing as herself and helping in our mystery!

Children of all ages unleashed their inner builder at our LEGO Build It program, open for an hour every afternoon for a week. Twenty-six crafters of all ages joined Stephanie and Janna at our DIY Craftshop program to create yarn paintings. The book club met with Stephanie to discuss their favorite books read in 2023 and then again to discuss The Searcher by Tana French.

Jennifer, Evie, Kim, and Janna provided stories and tours for field trips from Little Lamb Preschool and Little Country Preschool. Library Foundation President Deana Freres and Janna presented at Rotary. They received on behalf of the Foundation a check for \$2,000 to help fund access to the Dolly Parton Imagination Library. Janna ran the CCRLS Polk, Yamhill and Marion County (PYM) Library Directors meeting and attended the CCRLS Advisory Council meeting as the PYM Library Directors chair. Jennifer represented us at the PYM Children's Services meeting.
