SUBJECT: June Library report

Summer Reading blasted off on June 10 with programs for babies through adults. This summer's theme is "A Universe of Stories" and began with a Launch Party for all ages. Jennifer and Emily are taking Family Storytime on-the-go this summer, meeting at different locations throughout the community. June locations included Marketplace at the Grove and Stayton Fire Station.

Over two hundred people came to be entertained and educated by the Oregon Reptile Man, Richard Ritchey, and his reptile friends. Mr. Fantastic amazed a great crowd with his space magic show. Children decorated their own Summer Reading themed t-shirts, read to Willow, the therapy dog, and got their groove on at a Family Dance Party. They tested their skills at Astronaut Training and explored wind power at a Leap into Science workshop.
